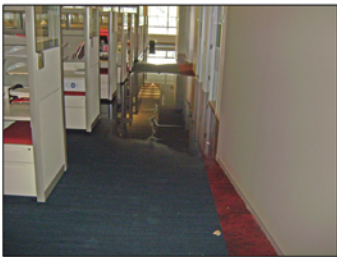


CVS CAREMARK

Monroeville, PA

CVS Caremark's Monroeville, PA call center and pharmaceutical delivery service office sustained water damage from a two inch fresh water supply line located in the ceiling of the second floor on Sunday, July 18, 2010.

The CVS Caremark property required specific security protocols to follow, due to the patient-doctor files located on site, the pharmaceuticals stored on site and the main server room that housed electronic copies of patient files.

This property was a former convention center built with a raised four inch metal "floating" floor above the concrete floor, this was built to conceal and house all of the cabling for electrical, phone and data lines. Due to the vast amount of water that filled the building this floor area was completely filled with water, creating a unique situation for extracting and drying the concrete flooring and cabling located within it, accessible only through access panels in the floor.

Also affected was a pharmaceutical grade clean room, which had been pre-built and placed intact in the property.

The property was completely reopened to the CVS Caremark in seven days. This unique project was completed by partnering with two local ServiceMaster franchises for equipment and manpower.
